

WHAT, WHERE, WHEN

Welcome to beautiful Bacalar, Mexico. Bacalar is an enchanting town located just four hours south of Cancun on the exquisite turquoise waters of "Laguna de Siete Colores" (The Lagoon of Seven Colors).

As of now, Casita Carolina is proud to sponsor the annual Art Rendezvous for painters. The Rendezvous is held the first full week of February. (We are planning to add a Spring, Summer and Fall Rendezvous tentatively scheduled for the first week in May, August and November)

Monday through Friday we will paint a different location in and around Bacalar, completing a minimum of five paintings per artist by Friday evening. Artists assemble on the Sunday prior to scout locations.

On Saturday, we hang the show, invite the town and have a party. Paintings are priced according to each artist. Other local artisans may be invited to display their crafts. A truly international event, the Art Rendezvous show brings community and creative expression together to create a unique experience you will remember forever.

The Exhibition begins at 5pm and goes until we send everyone home. The artist fee pays for the extra help, food, drinks and supplies needed for the show. Each artist is expected to mat his/her own pictures and help hang the exhibition.

DETAILS

COST: A \$45 fee will be charged for each person participating in addition to your room rental.

LODGING: Casita Carolina has a three-bedroom house and two guest houses for rent. All accommodations have private baths with communal kitchen and living areas available.

FOOD: Morning coffee is always served on the patio at Carolina's. The numerous options for breakfast, lunch and dinner are agreed upon Sunday evening. Meals can be a communal affair or we may vote to hire a cook. There are also several wonderful restaurants in Bacalar that would be happy to cater to our needs. If you prefer to prepare your own food, the local markets carry a large selection of fresh vegetables and fruit; the numerous butcher shops can provide fresh meats. For the speedy artist who also likes to paint with food, we would welcome your favorite dinner!!

SUPPLIES: All paintings must be matted for exhibition. We suggest you bring a minimum of five mats for your paintings in the size that you like to paint. Extra mats are greatly appreciated and can be sold to the "mat kitty". (If you forget your mats you can buy some from the "kitty" for a small price). If you have extra paints, brushes or paper, also bring them along – someone always forgets something and Cancun is a long drive to get materials!
